Code of Conduct: Club Officials & Coaches

A Club Official is a Trustee or person deployed by the Trustees.

Bradford and Bingley Canoe Club is an amateur club. All coaching and official duties are undertaken free of charge except by prior arrangement with the Trustees. Purchase Orders are issued and invoices obtained.

The essence of good practice is summarised below.

Coaches and officials must:

act within remits as provided by the Club as Deployer or their Coaching Qualification

and advertise activities which primarily benefit themselves as such (NB this can happen eg when coaches are being assessed or need logged sessions).

All officials & coaches must:

act within the remits as provided by the Club as Deployer or their coaching qualifications;

ensure that if they are providing an activity which is for their own benefit, that this is clear to participants, eg to build up a coaching portfolio or for assessment;

ensure all activities are appropriate to the age, ability and experience of those taking part;

promote the positive aspects of the sport (e.g. fair play, independence, risk assessment);

display appropriate standards of behaviour and appearance;

use proper language when taking part in club activities;

and follow and promote all guidelines laid down by the national governing body and the club.
